## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That Ben and Vivian M. Chapman

of Route 1, Box 68, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring and an unnamed stream

a tributary of unnamed stream (Little Luckiamute River) for the purpose of domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.2 acre lawn and garden,\* and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock from spring, and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W.M. Spring located: 320 feet North and 430 feet West from the Southeast corner NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 29  
Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows:  
Beginning at an iron pipe 5.058 chains South from the stone of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between Section 28 and 29 in Township 8 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon; and running thence South 15.072 chains to an Oak Stake; thence North 89° 34' West 26.54 chains; thence North 15.072 chains; thence South 89° 37' East 26.54 chains to the place of beginning.

\*stock use from a spring; and stock drinking directly from the unnamed stream and is limited not to exceed 14 head

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
