## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That Chester Cosgrove**

of Route 1, Box 47, Philomath, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Plunkett Creek

a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.9 acre (Tract 1) and stock drinking directly from the source and\* and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.011 cubic foot per second for irrigation and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within King DLC 39, Section 33, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W.M.  
Diversion point located: 1250 feet North and 1220 feet East from Southwest corner King DLC 39.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Tract 1

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within King DLC 39  
Section 33

Tract 2

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within King DLC 39  
Section 28

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within King DLC 39  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within King DLC 39  
Section 33  
Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Claim No. 39, Notification No 5145 in Township Ten South, Range Six West, and running thence East to the Kings Valley County Road, thence following along said road to the North line of the South half of said Claim No. 39, thence West to the West line of said claim, thence South on the West line of said claim to the place of beginning, containing 90 and 64/100 acres, more or less, in Benton County, Oregon.

\*is limited not to exceed 62 head (Tract 2)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
