CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Verda Crook

of 718 Hayter Street, Dallas State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Luckiamute River, commonly known as Little Luckiamute River

a tributary of Luckiamute River (Willamette River) for the purpose of stock drinking directly from the source and is limited not to exceed 23 head and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall ~~not exceed~~ be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
