CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Phillip D. and Delia M. Sperling

of Route 1, Box 159, Independence, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Luckiamute River (Willamette River) for the purpose of domestic use of one family and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Summer, 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ as projected within Vanderpool DLC 63 Section 17, T. 9 S., R. 4 W., W.M.
Spring located: 710 feet South and 80 feet East from Northwest corner Vanderpool DLC 63.

A Description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$
As projected within Vanderpool DLC 63
Section 20
Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
