CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Willamette Council of Camp Fire Girls, Inc.
by Mary M. Lewis, Executive Director

of 2555 State Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Taylor Spring

a tributary of Teal Creek (Little Luckiamute River) for the purpose of
domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.4 acre lawn and garden
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1877

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 8 S., R. 6 W., W.M.
Spring located: 470 feet South and 540 feet East from N $\frac{1}{2}$ corner, Section 32.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32
Township 8 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
