CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MELVIN S. CUMMINGS

of **4383 Country Lane NE, Salem, Oregon 97303**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application number R-48473, Permit number R-5886** a tributary of **Little Pudding River** for the purpose of **fish culture**

under Permit No. **36380** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 23, 1971**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within Herron DLC 52, Section 22, T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1740 feet South and 640 feet West from NE Corner, Herron DLC 52.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

As projected within Herron DLC 52
Section 22
T. 7 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
