CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That P. J. BROWN  
of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Powder River, a tributary of Snake River  
for the purpose of the irrigation of 486 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 at page 291;  
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for Tract No. 1 and  
1901 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot  
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-  
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:  
Tract No. 1: 4 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 20 acres  
in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 32 acres in the Southwest quarter of  
Southeast quarter and 3 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of  
Section Twenty-two: 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of  
Section Twenty-six: 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 40  
acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest  
quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest  
quarter; 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 33 acres in the  
Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township Eight Sout  
Range Forty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

(Claimant has a supplementary supply for 159 acres lying under the Perkins Ditch  
with a priority date of 1898 and for 259 acres lying under the Duncan ditch with a  
priority date of 1888 and these acreages overlap and are included in Tract No. 1)

Tract No. 2: 11 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 27.5  
acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 18 acres in the Northeast  
quarter of Southwest quarter; 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter  
31 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 6 acres in the Southwest  
quarter of Southeast quarter and 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast  
quarter of Section Twenty-two: 19 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter  
0.50 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-three:  
30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-six and  
8 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven,  
Township Eight South, Range Forty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County,  
Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
