and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume Tract No. 1 and that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 4 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 32 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 3 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quartor of Section Twenty-two: 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-six: 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 33 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township Eight Sout Range Forty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. (Claimant has a supplementary sumply for 159 acres lying under the Perkins Ditch , with a priority date of 1898 and for 259 acres lying under the Duncan ditch with a priority date of 1888 and these acreages overlap and are included in Tract No. 1)
