CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EVA ROSEEN NUNNELEY

of Route 2, Box 248-A, McMinnville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Baker Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.9 acre, and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 32502 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 5, 1967

that the amount of vater to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for frigation and 5.005 cubic foot per second for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk NEk, as projected within Brooks DLC 49, Section 16, T. 4 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 520 feet South and 170 feet West from the most Northerly NE Corner. Brooks DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.9 acre SWt NEt As projected within Brooks DLC 49 Section 16 T. 4 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
