and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and three-fourths acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW1 SE1, Section 10, T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M., 2450 feet North and 2440 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 10.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres SWk NWk Section 16 5.0 acres SEk NEk Section 17 T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 15, 1965, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to George H. and William Hall, Jr. and recorded at page 25269, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
