CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of **Prairie City**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **John Day River**

a tributary of Colubnia River irrigation of 43.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2892 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.54 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SE2, Section 10, T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M., 2380 feet North and 1450 feet West, 2450 feet North and 2440 feet West, Both from the SE Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres NW% SE% 40.0 acres SE% NW% Section 10 T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by orders of the State Engineer entered April 12, 1963, and March 15, 1965, and together with the cartificate recorded at page 39817, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Wm. J. Galbraith and recorded at page 3288, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
