CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. W. STURGESS

of **Beagle**, State of **Oregon**, has a right
to the use of the waters of **East Fork Evans Creek**

a tributary of **Evans Creek** for the purpose of

irrigation of 9.2 acres, domestic, and stock
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **4**, at page **1**; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from **1888**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.15 cubic foot per**
second

The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 16, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

1.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20
6.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
2.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered January 28, 1974, approves a change in
point of diversion for the irrigation of 8.8 acres. This certificate is issued
to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued
to D. W. Sturgess and recorded at page 16154, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
