that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT, Section 16, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

An order of the State Engineer entered January 28, 1974, approves a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 8.8 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to D. W. Sturgess and recorded at page 16154, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
