or its equivalent in case of notation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the RML NEL, Section 28, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for Enigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,
