CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOYCE J. PEEK

of 3901 Humbug Creek Road, Applegate, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Humbug Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 11.8 acres and domestic, and stock
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

An order of the Circuit Court of Jackson County entered January 27, 1969, canceled the right to the use of water for the irrigation of 6.0 acres, and corrected the location of the remaining right. An order of the State Engineer entered February 21, 1974, canceled the right to the use of water for the irrigation of 1.2 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and correct place of use and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Anna Walter and recorded at page 16431, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
