## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. O. and ALBERT BIGELOW

of Williams, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creeka tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 37.0 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1880that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.62 cubic feet per  
secondThe point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:20.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 817.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.An order of the State Engineer entered January 2, 1974, approved a change in point  
of diversion for the irrigation of 59.0 acres. This certificate is issued to  
confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to  
C. O. and Albert Bigelow and recorded at page 16318, State Record of Water Right  
Certificates.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
