CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. H. SUNDERMAN

of Echo, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Butter Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 14.3 acres, domestic, and stock and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 3, at page 250; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 34, T. 2 N., R. 27 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.3 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27 T. 2 N., R. 27 E., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered January 2, 1974, approves a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 164.1 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to A. H. Sunderman and recorded at page 2695, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
