CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON WILDLIFE COMMISSION

of P. O. Box 3503, Portland, State of Oregon 97208, has a right to the use of the waters of West Branch Ladd Creek

a tributary of Catherine Creek for the purpose of wildlife habitat and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second. This right shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.89 acre feet of water during any irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 35, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., W. M., 3100 feet South and 1330 feet East from NW Corner, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 35.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use, place of use, and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 31, 1969, and together with the certificate recorded at page 36612, Volume 28, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to John J. Peebler and recorded at page 6512, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
