This Is to Certify, That OREGON WILDLIFE COMMISSION

of P. O. Box 3503, Portland , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of Ladd Creek

a tributary of Catherine Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 4.0 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre,

The point of diversion is located in the SWk NWk, Section 1, T. 4 S., R. 38 E., W. M., 1400 feet South from the NW Corner, Section 1.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres SEt NWt Section I T. 4. S., R. 38 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 31, 1969, and together with the certificate recorded at page 36613, Volume 28, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to G. W. Jorris and recorded at page 6403, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
