irrigation of 2.0 acres and stock and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 10, at page 48; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-sixtieth of a

second foot per acre or a total of 3 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season from March 1st to October 1st, and outside of the irrigation season not to exceed one-tenth of a cubic foot per second for domestic and stock use.

The point of diversion is located in the NET NET, Section 24, T. 2 N., R. 11 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

2.0 acres NET NET Section 24 T. 2 N., R. 11 E., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered January 2, 1974, approves a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 3.0 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to William Terrill and recorded at page 8159, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
