CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PATRICK J. JOHNSTON

of **Route 1, Box 317, Woodburn**, State of **Oregon 97071**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Champoeg Creek & Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-43213, Permit No. R-5064** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 32.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 78.0 acres** under Permit No. **32873** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **February 26, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.02 cubic feet per second**.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Johnson DLC 54, Section 27, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 210 feet North and 1480 feet East from SW Corner, Section 27.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. **R-5064**, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to the terms of an agreement between **Arthur McKay, Patrick Johnston, Walter Wilmes and Neal Miller, recorded at page *** and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
