of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 30524 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes ajorcsaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NEX, Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M., 550 feet South and 1960 feet East from NX Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3% acre feat per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 14.0 acres SWk NEW Section 10 T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
