CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **NELSON C. & HOWARD O. TRIBBETT**
DBA: Tribbett & Sons

of **Star Route, Box 96, Saint Paul**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
two wells

a tributary of **Mission Creek (Willamette River)** for the purpose of
irrigation of 96.0 acres

under Permit No. **G-3213** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **March 22, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.20 cubic feet per second, being 0.55 cubic foot per second from Well No. 1 and
0.65 cubic foot per second from Well No. 2.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **#1 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, #2 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, both as projected within**
Plant DLC 66, Section 8, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., #1 - 1260 feet North and 3040 feet
East, #2 - 1230 feet North and 1530 feet East from NE Corner, Murphy DLC 97.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
