of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 32999 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 30, 1968 .

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NEX, as projected within Minard DLC 74, Section 7, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 2250 feet North and 940 feet West from NE Corner, Murphy DLC 97.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
