under Permit No. 33093 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 7, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NWL SWL, As projected within Joseph Cox DLC 38,

Section 5, T. 9 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 2700 feet North and 1900 feet West from NW

Corner, Thomas Cox DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to

of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 2½ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
