**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **GEORGE M. STUBBLEFIELD**

of **Monument**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **North Fork John Day River**

a tributary of **Columbia River**  
**irrigation of 22.8 acres**

for the purpose of

under Permit No. **14472** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 8, 1940**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.57 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 6, T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M., 1620 feet North and 3030 feet East from Center Section 1, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed **1 acre foot per acre** for each acre irrigated during any month and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed **5 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, from **April 1 to September 30** of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**1.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$**

**10.2 acres Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )**  
**Section 6**  
**T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M.**

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 22, 1969, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. M. Stubblefield and recorded at page 24096, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
