a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 22.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 14472 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 8, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is emitted and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.57 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NWk NWk), Section 6, T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M., 1620 feet North and 3030 feet East from Center Section 1, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, from April 1 to September 30 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
