CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLARENCE L. PHILLIS

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon 97063, has a right
to the use of the waters of
Tygh Creek

a tributary of White River for the purpose of
irrigation of 16.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from July 1888

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre
during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph
24 of said decree);

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 3 S., R. 12 E., W. M.,
1300 feet South and 4160 feet East from NW Corner, Section 36.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

13.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
3.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 36
T. 3 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered September 30, 1968, and supersedes certi-
ficate of water right heretofore issued to Roy B. Haines and recorded at page
5745, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
