CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOHN C. CHRISTENSON ESTATE, by John H. Ingram,
 Executor,
 of Haines, State of Oregon. has a right to the use of
 the waters of Rock Creek, a tributary of Powder River, and Powder River, a tributary
 of Snake River;
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 308.5 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February, 1900, for 173 acres in
 Tract No. 1; 1878 for 135.5 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic
 foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Rock Creek: 37 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 38 acres in the
 Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; and 35.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of
 Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-four; 8.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of
 Northeast quarter, and 14 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of
 Section Thirty-three;

Tract No. 2 from Powder River: 37 acres in the Northeast quarter of North-
 west quarter; 32 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 31 acres in
 the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 35.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of
 Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-nine
 East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
