CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That FRED COLE & R.W. LITTLEFIELD, Administrator
 Estate of D. S. Littlefield, deceased
 of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Elk Creek, a tributary of Powder River
 for the purpose of Placer mining and sale for irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 150 miners inches;
 and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
 tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of use: South half of Section Fifteen and Southeast quarter of
 Section Sixteen, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-nine East, of Willamette Meridian,
 in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
