under Permit No. 34290 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 22, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second** 

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL SEL, as projected within H. Small DLC 57, Section 29, T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 1420 feet North and 260 fee. East from Sk Corner. Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

O.3 acre NW2 SE2 As projected within Small DLC 57 Section 29 T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
