CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That scio water improvement district

of Route 3, Box 273, Scio, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Thomas Creek

a tributary of South Santiam River irrigation of 123.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32841 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 16, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.54 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWZ SEX, Section 10, T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 860 feet North and 2640 feet East from SW Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiath of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation seeson of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres SWk SEk Section 8

22.8 acres SWk NWk 22.6 acres SEk NWk Section 16

39.0 acres NWk NEt 18.5 acres NEt SEt 4.8 acres SWk SEt 8.3 acres SEt SEt Section 17 T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
