CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **DIXIE CULVER
& ECHO LARSON**

of **2814 15th Place, Forest Grove**, State of **Oregon**, **97116**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of **Tualatin River** for the purpose of **domestic use of one family and stock**

under Permit No. **35014** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **March 18, 1970**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.017 cubic foot per second, being 0.0085 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.0085 cubic foot per second for stock use**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., 480 feet South and 360 feet West from NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
