## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That GEORGE IRVIN

of Ashland , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of Ashland Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.7 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1858

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.048 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NWt NWt, Section 9, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 200 feet South and 825 feet East from NW Corner, Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres NW SW SW Section 4
T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to George Irwin and recorded at page 16018, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 2.5 acres. A change in use, place of use, and point of diversion for the irrigation of 0.8 acre was approved by order of the State Engineer entered April 2, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George Irwin.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
