confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three-eightieths of one cubic foot per second per acre of land irrigated, and not to exceed one and one-half acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days during the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located in the SW SW SW Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 48 E., W. M., 320 feet North and 130 feet East from SW Corner, Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
