CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWIN R. WERNER

of **13848 Deerhorn Road, Springfield**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, unnamed slough and reservoir constructed under Application number **R-42198**, Permit number **R-4812** a tributary of **McKenzie River** for the purpose of **domestic use of one family and recreation**

under Permit No. **31714** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 9, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from stream for domestic, and 0.05 cubic foot per second from stream and reservoir for recreation with any deficiency in the available supply from the stream to be made up by * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.** The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 26, T. 17 S., R. 1 W., W. M., unnamed stream - 1000 feet North and 970 feet East, unnamed slough - 1319 feet North and 350 feet East, reservoir - 250 feet North and 25 feet East, all ****

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

*** appropriation from the slough provided the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second.**

**** from SW Corner, Lot 5, Section 26.**

Section 26

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
