under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters G-1147 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 3, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said perposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 SE2, Section 24, T. 3 N., R. 33 E., W. M., 660 feet North and 1070 feet East from St Corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited io one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per scre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 4.6 acres SWk SEk 0.5 acre SEX SEX Section 24 T. 3 N., R. 33 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
