that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforessed, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NWk SWk, Section 30, T. 6 N., R. 36 E., W. H., 720 feet North and 990 feet East from SW Corner, NWk SWk, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of post to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;
