CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **DAVE UMBARGER**

of **Route 1, Box 220, Pendleton**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Patawa Creek**

a tributary of **Umatilla River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 101.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 194.9 acres**

under Permit No. **34360** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 2, 1969**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **2.11 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **#1-NW¼ NE¼, #2-NE¼ NW¼, Section 20, #3-SE¼ SW¼, Section 17, T. 2 N., R. 33 E., W. M., #1-680 feet South, #2-510 feet West, #3-630 feet North and 1320 feet West, all from N¼ Corner, Section 20.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4¼** acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
