a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and domestic hook up for 66 trailer sites, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area per family under Permit No. 35001 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX SEX, Section 29, T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M., 566 feet North and 20 feet West from SE Corner, Section 29.
