CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALVIN O. KNOPF

of **Route 1, Walla Walla**, State of **Washington**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **two wells**

a tributary of **Walla Walla River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 7.6 acres and supplemental irrigation of 54.6 acres**

under Permit No. **G-5046** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 11, 1971**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.75 cubic foot per second, being 0.19 cubic foot per second from Well #1 and 0.56 cubic foot per second from Well #2**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **#1 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, #2 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., - 2890 feet North and 1560 feet East, #2 - 3450 feet North and 1350 feet East from SW Corner, Section 15.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
