CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED KNAPE

97824

of **Route 1, Box 163, Cove**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Grande Ronde River**

a tributary of **Snake River** for the purpose of irrigation of **335.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 25.0 acres**

under Permit No. **28560** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 30, 1962**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **2.40 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 2 S., R. 39 E., W. M., 2380 feet South and 600 feet West, 2780 feet South and 1400 feet West, both from N $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 32.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the **Lower Grande Ronde River** is more than **300 cubic feet per second** at USGS Gage No. **3325** and more than **420 cubic feet per second** at Oregon-Washington border,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
