**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE FISH COMMISSION**

of **307 State Office Building, Portland**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **North Fork Nehalem River, unnamed stream, and ponds constructed under Application No. R-42033, Permit No. R-4779** a tributary of **Nehalem River** for the purpose of **domestic use of three families and fish culture**

under Permit No. **31450** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **March 25, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **20.22 cubic feet per second, being 20.0 c.f.s. from North Nehalem River for fish culture and domestic and 0.22 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for fish culture**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 22, Lot 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 27, T. 4 N., R. 9 W., W. M., River-510 feet North and 1080 feet West, stream-677 feet South and 723 feet West, both from N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 27.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 22  
T. 4 N., R. 9 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
