a tributary of North Fork Nehalem River for the purpose of domestic use of two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden for house No. 1 under Permit No. 33505 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for House No. 2 and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring for house No. 1 with any deficiency in the available supply from the spring for house No. 1 to be made up by appropriation from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SH NEX), Lot 10 (NW SEX), Section 8, T. 4 N., R. 8 W., W. M., spring- 390 feet North and 470 feet East, stream - 480 feet South and 1220 feet East, both from Center, Section 8.
