CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAISLEY RANGER DISTRICT

of Dept. of Agriculture, P.O. Box 551, Lakeview, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Moss Spring

a tributary of Young Creek for the purpose of public campground use and stock

under Permit No. 29160 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 12, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for public campground and 0.01 cubic foot per second for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 36 S., R. 19 E., W. M., North 10 degrees East 950 feet from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Campground SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Stock SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
T. 36 S., R. 19 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
