CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDNA VALENTINE

of P. O. Box 663, Jacksonville, , State of Oregon, , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Armstrong Gulch

a tributary of Sterling Creek (Little Applegate River) for the purpose of domestic use of one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 3026 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SEt SWt, Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

Diversion point located 555 feet South and 410 feet West from the northeast corner of the SEt SWt, Section 8.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Ansil Gilson and R. S. Bullis and recorded at page 1842, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 4.0 acres, domestic and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 4.0 acres and stock was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered October 23, 1974. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for domestic use, including the irrigation of not to exceed 0.5 acre lawn and garden and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Ansil Gilson and R. S. Bullis.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforescid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
