CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That EAST BAKER IRRIGATION & MILLING CO. of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of the irrigation of 300 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for 90 acres and 1887 for 210 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Lots and Blocks in the City Limits of Baker not to exceed 90 acres.

40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nine: 2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 36 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 24 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 16 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Ten and 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-eight, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon;

(The right through the New Home Ditch was first initiated through the Bamberger Ditch and in 1904 changed to the New Home Ditch)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
