CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOHN J. NELSON**  
dba: Hood River Sand, Gravel & Ready Mix  
97031

of **P. O. Box 155, Hood River**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
**Columbia River**

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of  
**Industrial (washing and screening gravel and operation of cement mixing plant)**

under Permit No. **29725** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from **June 8, 1964**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
**4.44 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 2 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 6, T. 2 N., R. 8 E.,**  
**W. M., 570 feet North and 640 feet West from SE Corner, Lot 2 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 6.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

This right is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities  
to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

**Lot 2 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4)**  
**Section 6**  
**T. 2 N., R. 8 E., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
