Route 1, Box 169, Hood River , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Neal Creek

Hood River a tributary of Hood River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.0 scres, operation of a cold storage and fruit packing plant

30389 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 21, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-14 cubic foot per second, being 0-04 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.10 cubic foot per second for operation of a cold storage and fruit packing plant

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SEA, Section 24, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M., 480 feet North and 230 feet East from St. Corner, Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Cold Storage and Fruit Packing Plant and 3.0 acres SWt SEt Section 24 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
