CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLIFFORD HUFFMAN and/or ARLO BOUSLAUGH 97525

of P. O. Box 195, Gold Hill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 0.3 acre and domestic use of two families

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31019 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 8, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SEX, Section 16, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 490 feet North and 510 feet East from SW Corner, NEX SEX, Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4% acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: \vdots

0.3 scre and Domestic NEW SEX Section 16 T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
